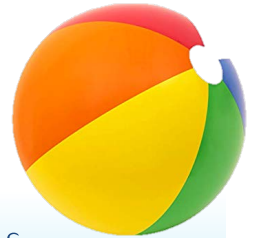
Happy Summer Season 2026

How to avoid a GREEN pool this summer

Bather Load - Based on the size of your pool, it is important to manage the number of swimmers in your pool at a given time. The natural organics can be sanitized to a certain degree but will underperform if the load is too high. Overuse of a pool will necessitate additional chemical charges.

Cloudy Pools - If your pool is starting to turn cloudy, it's EXTREMELY important to stop using it and call us for help.

Pump & Skimmer Baskets - For those with dogs that swim and/or heavy debris, please clean out your pump and skimmer baskets in between service visits to ensure proper circulation of your pool. This especially applies to Partial Service accounts as we do not clean out your baskets.

Preventative Algae Treatment (\$149) - There are always algae spores in the porous surface of your pool. We can help prevent this from becoming a problem by adding an algae prevention treatment and help keep green walls at bay! Please reach out to schedule a treatment.

Deck Autofiller - If your pool requires manual filling, we can help with this. Please reach out to eh office to see if a deck autofiller is right for you.

Customer Responsibilities

Just a friendly reminder about homeowner/tenant responsibilities that help our service technicians better maintain your pool.

- Maintain the proper water level to avoid serious damage to pool, spa, pond, or fountain equipment.
- Keep trees and plants trimmed away from pool, spa and equipment. (Not to hang over deck of pool and/or spa.)
- Provide clear access to pool, spa and equipment and keep pump area clean of debris, animal feces, and overgrown vegetation.
- Remove pool covers, solar covers/rings, toys, rafts, etc. on day of service.
- It is the customer's responsibility to assure that all gates are operating properly. Service technician assumes no responsibility for maintaining fences or gates at customer's property.

Upcoming Filter Service - \$110

To maintain adequate circulation, and properly sanitized water, our goal is to evaluate and clean your filter 1-2 times per year for preventative maintenance. If we have not cleaned your filter in the last few months, you will automatically be placed on the schedule. Once evaluated and cleaned, we will report if any grids or further repairs are necessary for proper filtration.

Please call us immediately if you do NOT wish your filter to be serviced.
